Meeting Attendance

We, as an Association, can only be successful if we are active participants. Active members attend meetings regularly. There are times when members wish to attend workshops offered outside of an Association meeting. This is acceptable, however attendance credit cannot be extended to participation in outside workshops.

Membership Benefits

Greensboro Food Bank Program

Participation in the program permits the member to shop at the Greensboro Food Bank. Dates for food pick-ups are Tuesdays and Thursdays at Greensboro Urban Ministries located at 305 West Lee Street in Greensboro. Members must attend four (4) meetings in order to qualify and attend six (6) meetings per fiscal year to stay in good standing for participation in the Food Bank Program.



We meet monthly, on the second Saturday of the month, from 9:30AM to 12:00PM. Our meetings are usually held at Guilford Child Development located at 1200 Arlington Street in Greensboro, NC. There are certain months when we meet elsewhere. When the location is changed a phone committee member will call to let you know of the change.
